

Shri Avadh Behari Lal Gupta alias 'Tanmay' was born on 24th December, 1932. He completed his graduation in Civil Engineering in 1958 and retired from Central Public Department, New Delhi from a senior post in 1990.

In 1980 he wrote a thesis on Homoeopathy, the summary of which was published in V/10 issue of January 1982 of an International magazine known as HMAI.

As a result of his diligent studies in Vedic literature, Homoeopathy and Science, he came out with a scientific paper on Gayatri Mantra in 1997. This paper was for the first time published in the issue of June 1997, Vol.10/9 of a prestigious monthly magazine of Sydney (Australia) known as 'The Indian down under'. 


While the book is for a Hindi-speaking audience, an English version can take it to a larger readership.
